

HOW TO ENROL IN THE UNICEF “*Child Rights and Why They Matter*” TRAINING COURSE

1. On your Web browser, type in <https://agora.unicef.org>
2. Click **LOGIN**.



3. On the **LOGIN** page, go to the Guest login panel and click **Create new account**.

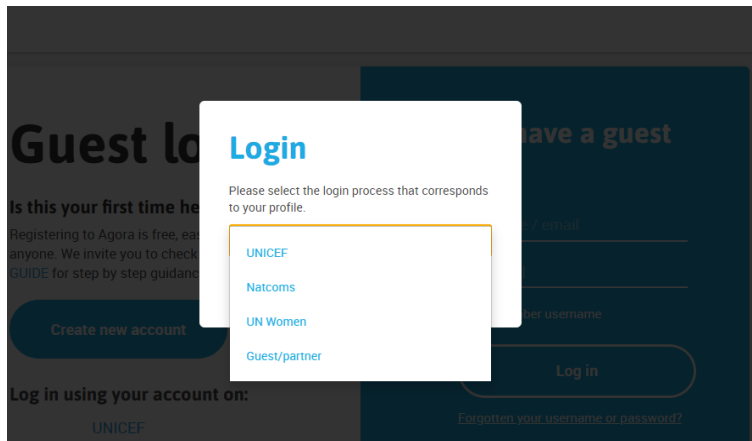

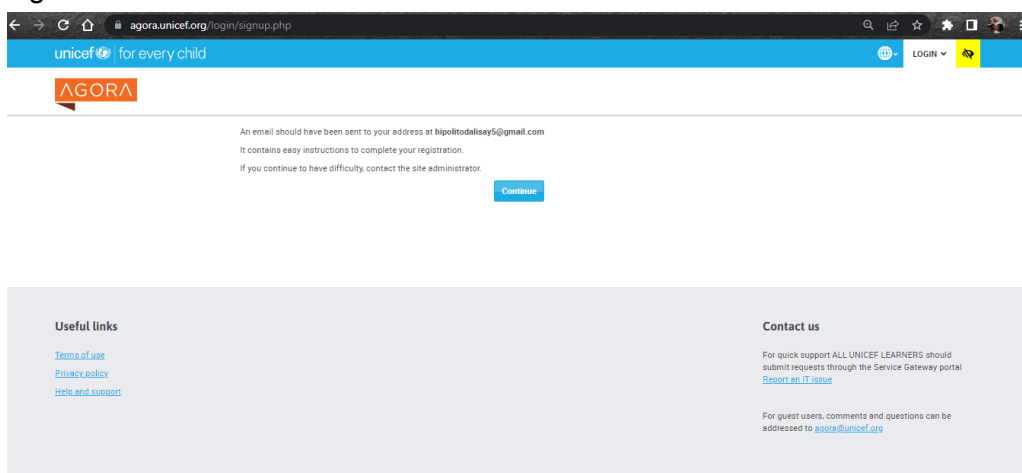

4. A **Login** dialog will appear. Select **Guest/partner** to register as a guest.

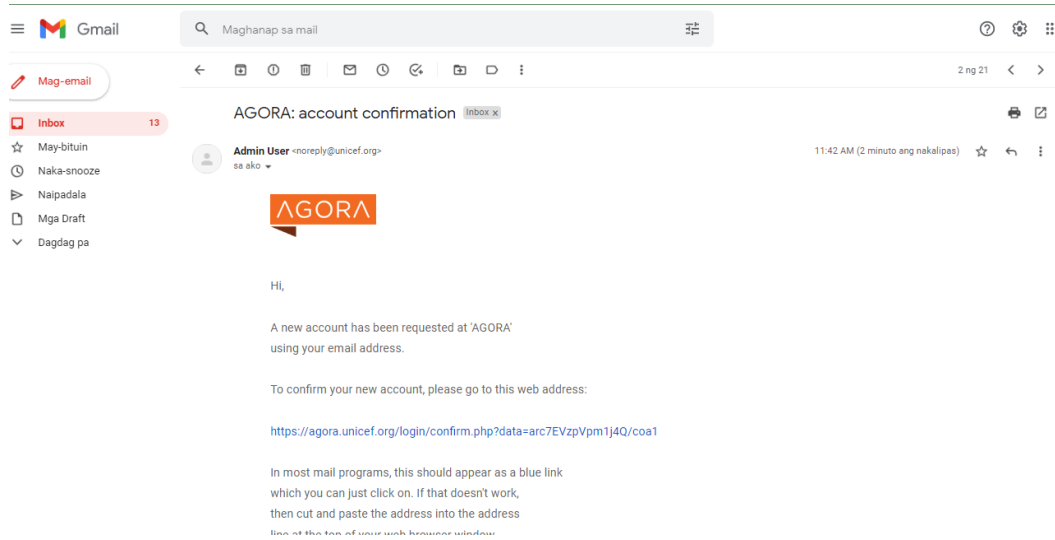


5. Fill up your personal information in the form provided.

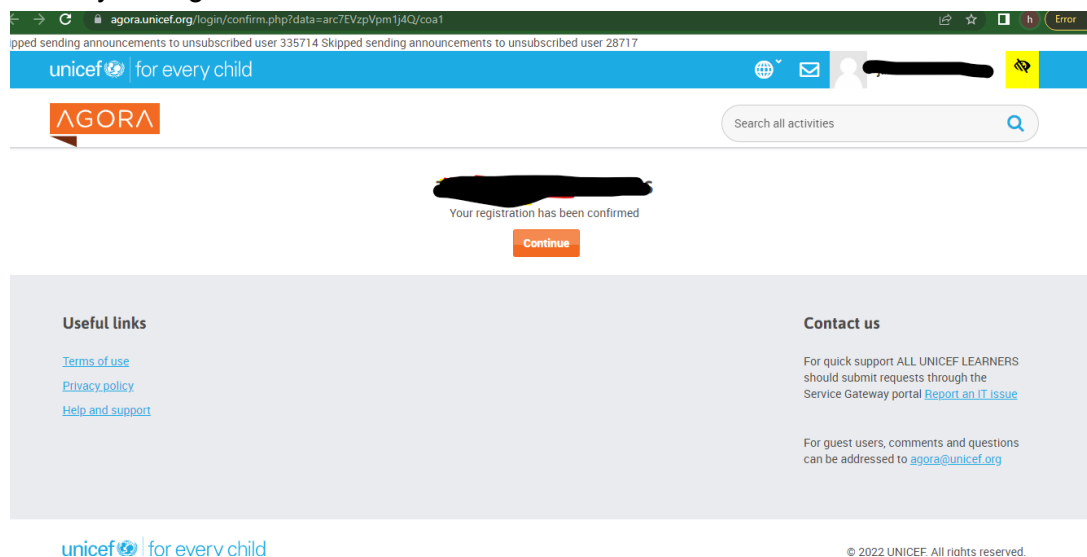
6. Once finished click **Submit**. An **Account Confirmation** will then be sent to your registered email address.



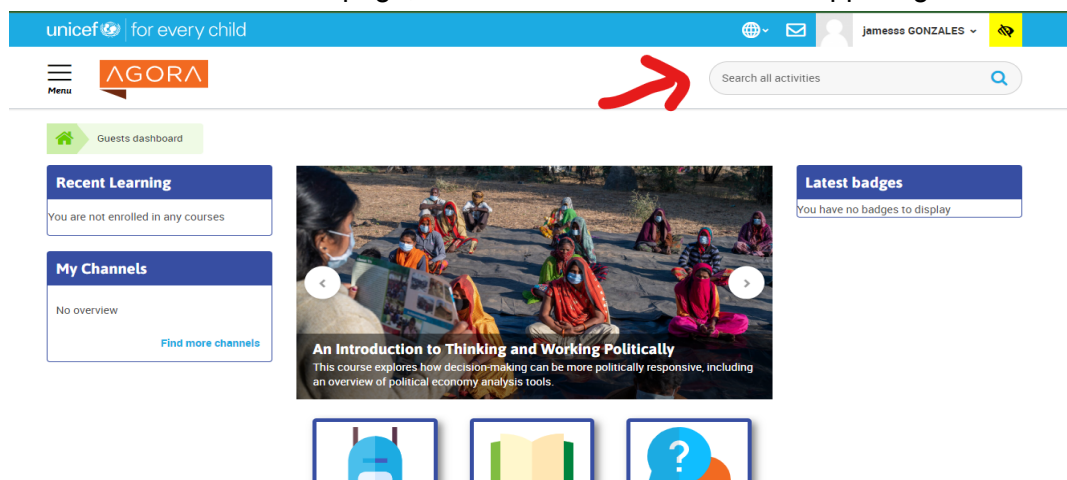
7. Click the **your email's inbox for an Account confirmation email provided by Agora**. Click the provided link to confirm your registration.



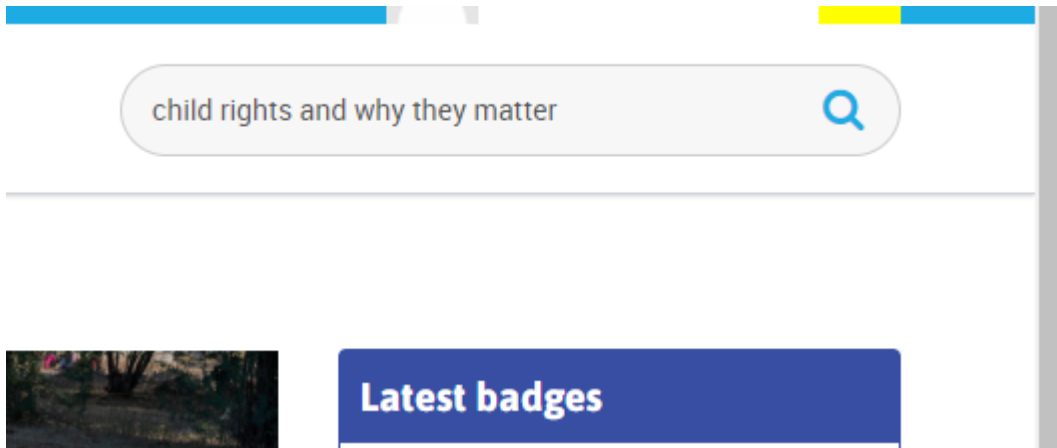
9. Once your registration has been confirmed, click **Continue**.



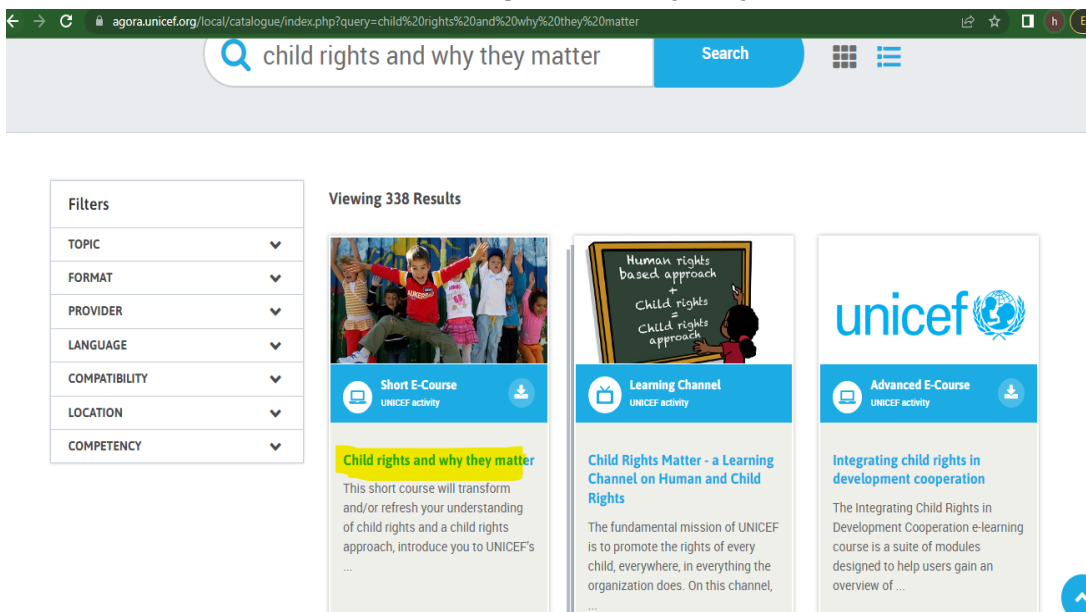
10. On the AGORA home page, look for the Search Bar at the upper right corner.



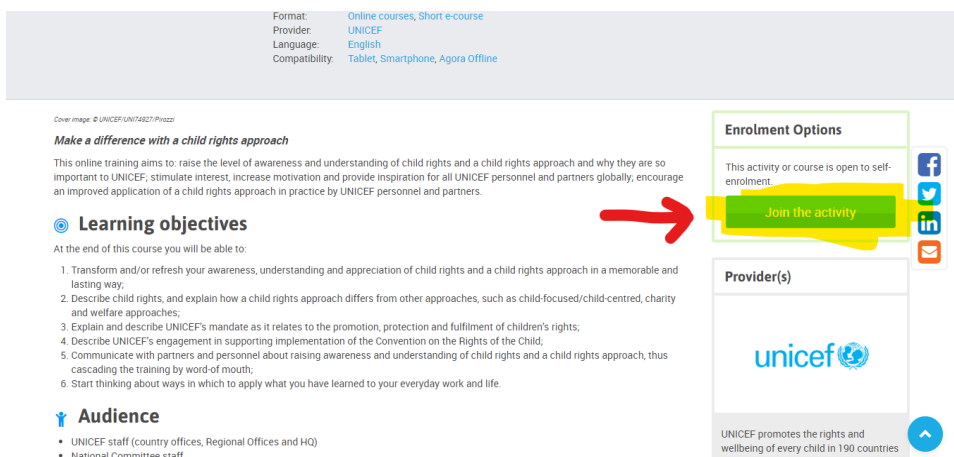
11. Search for the term **Child Rights and why they matter**.

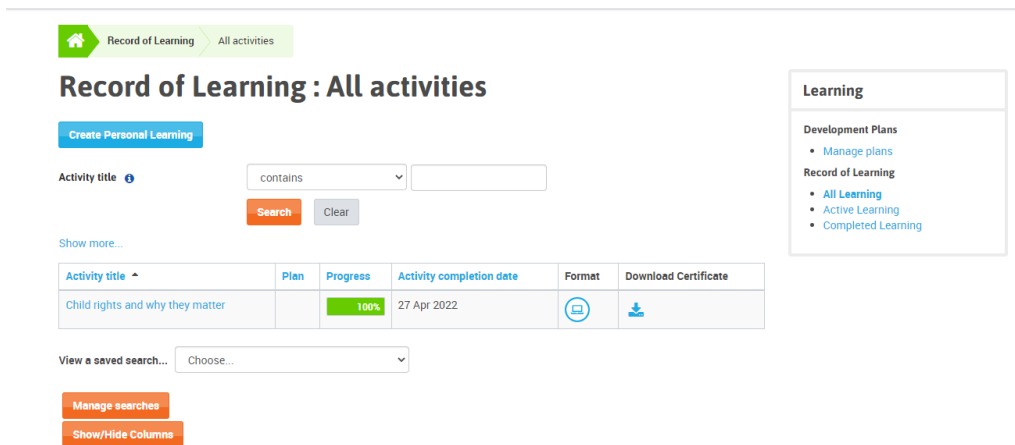
After completing all eight (8) modules, you will then be able to get your certificate of completion.
